2. Limaland Tour:

Limaland Tour 2022 report/review. Mark reported that the tour was held on June 18th and weather was great. We had 73 riders. 2018 – 118 riders; 2019 – 84 riders with bad weather, cool and rainy; 2020 & 2021 – did not have tour due to pandemic.

We donated \$300 to Wheelhouse and \$300 to the Lafayette Historical Society. Sponsorship = \$2,900. Profit = \$723. We increased the entry fee by \$5. Rider event insurance \$9.40/rider for non-members.
